This action is co-financed in joint co-financing by:

- Guatemala for an amount of EUR 1,000,000;
- This action is co-financed by potential grant beneficiaries for an indicative amount of EUR 704,250.

The proposed action contributes to the Team Europe Initiative (TEI) “Alliance for Sustainable Growth and Jobs”. This TEI seeks to support Guatemala in its efforts to establish a new sustainable and inclusive economic model that guarantees the protection of workers and mobilises sufficient domestic revenues to finance the country's necessary social investments. This action advances to this purpose by working to improve labour market access for all, particularly for young people, women, returning migrants, persons with disabilities and the indigenous population in line with the National Policy for Decent Employment 2017 – 2032 (PNED). The implementation of this TEI will be coordinated with Member States, notably Germany, which also supports VET education and employment promotion programmes. The commitment of the EU’s contribution to the Team Europe Initiatives foreseen under this annual action plan will be complemented by other contributions from Team Europe partners. It is subject to the formal confirmation of each respective partners’ meaningful contribution as early as possible. In the event that the TEIs and/or these contributions do not materialise the EU action may continue outside a TEI framework.
