<p>The Action seeks to enhance the accountability and the efficiency of the public institutions that are responsible for the: 1) formulation and implementation of the National Budget, through which public services are delivered; and 2) fiscal and macro-economic policies through which sustainable growth and social development are protected and enhanced.</p> <p>Prior EU Public Finance Management (PFM) programs spearheaded efforts to establish a more strategic, systemic and sustainable approach to the PFM reform and to the underlying IT developments with, notably, the elaboration of the PFM Strategy 2024-2034, the Planning and Budgeting roadmap, the IT Master Plan, the revision of General State Accounts or the development of e-SISTAFE modules.
